Please note that we reserve the right to make an administration fee of £5.00 per child for changing arrangements previously agreed.

### Cancellations

In the event of a cancellation the following conditions apply:

If you cancel your booking more than four weeks before the Day Camp Week we may charge an administration fee of £30.00, but if you cancel less than four weeks there will be no refund.

All cancellations must be made in writing.

### Insurance

Please note the centre holds a Public Liability insurance policy with a single claim limit of £10 million. You may wish to consider 'personal accident' insurance cover. Full details of this including a cancellation cover, can be sent to you upon request.
